Member Spotlight: St Vincent de Paul Society Swan Hill

In May, we had St Vincent de Paul Society join up as a Food Hub member. St Vincent de Paul Society is a key organisation in Swan Hill which provides food relief for our community. The partnership between Food for All and St Vincent de Paul Society demonstrates flexibility in membership options for the Food Hub with monthly payments.



Each week St Vincent de Paul provides around 30 people with food relief and in the month of May has provided 140 people with food through the Food for All Food Hub. This increased reach of the Food Hub to vulnerable people experiencing food insecurity is a key achievement for both St Vincent de Paul Society and Food For All.
